

# SOCCER SOURCE 360

The Soccer Source 360 is a professional organization dedicated to providing soccer education at its best for your child. Thousands of children throughout Maryland have enjoyed the unforgettable experience this program achieves for each camper.

Soccer Source 360's unique philosophy creates a learning environment that is enjoyable and stress free, encouraging each child to fulfill their true potential. The goal is to develop natural abilities, improve techniques and create skillful and sportsmanlike soccer players which will enable each child to enjoy soccer to its fullest. The sessions are open to all levels of experience.

## ***Some time-tested camp highlights include:***

- A dynamic warm up: the entire camp will meet for 30 minutes to prepare for the day. We use the principle of "one needs to control their body before being able to control the ball, and one needs to be able to control the ball before controlling the game". Therefore, each warm up starts without the ball. The ball is introduced after players have a better understanding of body control.
- Two dribbling moves are taught each day.
- All sessions are developed in a simple to complex manner.
- The guided-discovery coaching method is used.
- Each session ends with a small sided game.

# CREATIVE KIDS CAMP

Campers spread their wings and soar at Creative Kids Camp, where the emphasis is on **creativity and fun!** Each camp day is spent exploring:

# BEFORE AND AFTER CARE

These extended-day offerings are available for all camps (except Fast Break Basketball Clinic). During Before Care and After Care, lightly structured activities and free play areas are supervised by camp staff. The Recreation Department supports proper nutrition for extended-day campers by offering breakfast and snacks at no extra charge:

- **Breakfast** is served during Before Care, up to 8:15am. Campers can choose one of three nutritious breakfast options: (1) a bowl of Cheerios, (2) a slice of whole-grain toast with peanut butter, or (3) a bowl of instant oatmeal, each with milk and juice or fresh fruit.
- A **nutritious snack** is provided to all campers during After Care.

Before care and after care take place in the same building as the regular camp in which the camper is enrolled, except for Spring Circus Camp and Camp Encore. Campers in those camps are escorted by staff between locations.

## AFTER CARE CLASSES

For campers interested in pottery and the ceramic arts, **Clay At The End Of The Day** is offered as an alternative to regular After Care, while campers interested in learning to play rock music can choose **Rock At The End Of The Day**. An additional option this year is the **Tennis Aftercare Program** which will be offered the second and fourth sessions. All classes run from 3:30pm-5:15pm. Nutritious snacks are provided. Campers are escorted from their respective camps to the After Care classrooms by staff. **After Care**, until 6:00pm, is available for campers following these classes. # CLAY AT THE END OF THE DAY

Ages 6-14

Greenbelt Community Center - 15 Crescent Road, third floor studios



For campers who are interested in pottery and ceramic arts, these classes offer an alternative to traditional after-care. Campers ages 6-9 will learn hand-building and decoration techniques, creating sculpture and pottery. Children ages 11 to 14 will be introduced to the potter's wheel, and will have the option to work on hand-building projects as well. Ten year old campers may participate in either class according to their experience and abilities. Campers may be picked up in the Community Center Multi-purpose room (201) at 5:15pm.

Inside tip: learning to throw pots on the wheel is great fun, but also challenging – even for adults! Throwing requires strength, fine motor control and concentration. Youth wheel classes are a great opportunity for students who can maintain focus for extended periods of time, who are receptive to instruction and who are resilient in the learning process.

**COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORMS:** Can be printed and mailed, faxed, or dropped off in-person. Mail-in and faxed registrations will be dated and entered accordingly. Camper registration forms will be accepted on an ongoing basis until all slots are filled. At that point, interested persons' names will be placed on a waiting list. Those persons will be contacted in the order in which names were taken if/when a slot becomes available.

### Greenbelt Recreation Department Medication Policies:

Each medication, prescription and non-prescription, medical device (insulin pump) or emergency medical device (inhaler, epi-pen) requires a separate medication authorization form **signed by the child's physician.**

All medications must be self-administered. The child **MUST** be able to name and recognize their medication and know how to administer the proper dosage. Staff is not authorized to administer medication and will only supervise the self-administration.

Prescriptions must be in the original pharmacy container, labeled by a registered pharmacist, with the name of child, name of physician, name of medication, date filled, prescription number and directions for administration. Expired medication will not be accepted.

Over-the-counter, non-prescription medication must be in the original packaging, with the name of the child, name of physician, date and directions for administration affixed. Expired medication will not be accepted.

Non-emergency medication will be secured in locked storage at the location of the camp. On field trips, medication will be in the secure possession of the staff member with primary responsibility for the child.

Emergency medical devices (inhaler, epi-pen) will remain in the secure possession of the staff member with primary responsibility for the child during camp hours.

I have read and understand the above policies and will supply the Greenbelt Recreation Department with the proper equipment/supplies needed for my child to self-administer the medication.

I understand that the physician will be called if a question arises about my child's medication.

I understand 911 will be called in an emergency.

I request the authorized youth camp operator or staff to supervise the child in self-administration as prescribed by the above authorized prescriber.
