- Wares** This fair supports artists, artisans and other community members in the sale of their own, original, hand-made creations. No kit crafts, imports and commercially produced items are permitted. (Limited exceptions may be granted to non-profit groups for items which promote their organization or its mission.) Edible goods are not permitted. Corporate logos and copyrighted imagery are prohibited, with the exception of recycled materials and the artist's or group's own graphics.
- DIY Room** ***New option!*** Check the box on your application if you would be interested in leading hands-on craft activities on a fee-per-project basis, either in addition to or instead of selling finished crafts.
- Schedule** Fri, Dec 3: set up 5-9pm; fair not yet open. Sat, Dec 4: set up: 8-9:30am. Fair open 10am-5pm.
Sun, Dec 5: fair open 11am-4pm. Load out 4-6pm. Exhibitors must be present and stocked both days, all fair hours.
- Where** Youth and Non-Profit exhibitors will occupy room 103 in the Greenbelt Community Center. The Center is easily accessible by these major routes: MD 193, MD 201, the Washington Beltway, and the Baltimore-Washington Parkway.
- Fees** *No fee to apply.* Youth exhibitors: \$20.00 per space. Non-profit exhibitors (100% of profits going to the non-profit organization): \$20.00 per space. Non-profit groups splitting revenues between the organization and individual members: \$30 per space. Each space includes the use of a 6' table and 2 folding chairs. Payment due upon acceptance. Do not send payment with application. Booth fees are nonrefundable.
- Sales tax** Maryland requires all exhibitors, including youth and non-profits, to have a tax number and collect sales tax. If you do not have a State tax identification number, the State Comptroller's office will contact you to provide a temporary number.
- Security** The exhibit rooms will be locked at night. Additional security measures are limited to cameras in the halls, and building staff during public hours. The Recreation Department cannot be responsible for any articles lost, stolen, or damaged.
- To apply** Please complete the attached application and return it by October 1 to Barbara Dickey Davis at the Greenbelt Community Center. Please enclose clear photos or cd (no original artwork) of pieces which are representative of the items you plan to sell, plus a photo of your booth set up. A self-addressed stamped envelope is required if you wish to have your photos/cd returned. All items to be sold must be clearly described in the application.
- Application Process:** Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis throughout the year. Exhibitors will be informed of their acceptance status by October 8, the published notification date. Acceptance will be contingent on past compliance with fair guidelines. Once notified of acceptance, exhibitors must provide full payment by October 22. If payment is not received when due, the exhibitor may lose his/her space at the fair. Decisions of the Recreation Department regarding acceptance to the show and booth space assignments are final and not subject to appeal.
- Cancellations** If you are accepted to the fair but cannot attend, please notify the Recreation Department. If you fail to provide notification or if you do not participate on both days during all fair hours you may be excluded from future fairs.
- Additional Policies** Exhibitors are required to supply their own fabric to drape and skirt all tables to the floor. Exhibitors may not post signage in the building, except in their booth. Craft demonstrations are encouraged. Exhibitors must supply their own wheeled carts for transport of all materials into and out of the building.
