## About the program...

The Greenbelt Assistance in Living (GAIL) Program in an effort to further fair housing, has been awarded a grant to offer qualified Greenbelt residents a limited number of accessibility items, installation and home modifications to enable seniors and disabled adults in need to remain in their homes as long as possible. This program will fund items such as:

- Standard Motorized Stair Lifts
- Interior Stair Railings
- Widening Doorways
- Low-threshold Shower Entrance
- Safety Grab Bars
- A Handicap-Accessible Toilets
- Toilet Seat Risers
- Standard Shower Chairs
- Portable Metal Ramps
- Safety Vertical Floor to Ceiling Poles
- Bed Rails

**Note:** The equipment awarded to each household will be determined based on number of applicants, funds available, priority, and individual need. Applications will be considered on a first come first serve basis.

## Eligibility Requirements

This program is open to Greenbelt residents who are 62 and older or disabled\*. Renters must have the written approval of property owner prior to grant approval. Applications will be evaluated based on financial and demonstrated needs. A home visit will be scheduled as part of the application process. In order to qualify for this program, applicants must have a gross annual income below \$44,800 for a single person household or \$51,200 for a two-person household. Proof of your gross monthly income and assets are required. Proof should include the following:

- 2009 Tax Forms
- Proof of all income in the last 30 days:
  - Social Security Award Letter,
  - Disability Pension Statement,
  - Social Security Disability Income Pension Statement, and/or Pay Stub.
- Proof of Liquid Assets: Bank Statements, Stock Dividends, Annuity, etc.
- Disability must be determined by a Social Security Disability Award or Disability Pension Award.
