CITY ELECTION-NOVEMBER 5, 2013

The upcoming City Election will be Tuesday, November 5, 2013, between the hours of 7 am and 8 pm. Registered city voters will be voting for seven at-large City Council seats. Information on each of the candidates is posted at www.greenbeltmd.gov.



YOUR VOTING OPTIONS:

1. EARLY VOTING: Any qualified registered voter will again have the opportunity to vote early or absentee. Early voting will begin on October 19th according to the schedule below. Voters may vote early at any of these times and locations.

LEAF VACUUM SCHEDULE FALL 2013-2014

The City Public Works Department will again collect loose leaves from the following areas with the leaf vacuum from November 4, 2013 until January 17, 2014. We remind residents to rake the leaves to the curb, but not into the street, and to remove all sticks and stones from the pile as these can damage the machinery. Areas to be collected will be posted as in past years. We also remind residents not to park in front of leaf piles.
