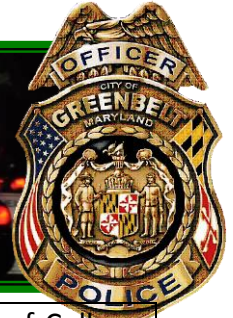

The victim advised that he was walking to a residence when he was approached by the three suspects, with one demanding the victim's backpack. After obtaining the backpack all three suspects fled the area on foot. The suspects area described as a Hispanic male 20 to 30 years of age, 5'7", wearing a black hoodie, a black male 5'7" with a light complexion and a black male 5'8" with a light complexion.

The suspect was released on citation pending trial.
11/05 11:28 A.M.	9000 block Breezewood Terrace. Burglary arrest. A 17 year old Greenbelt youth was arrested for 4 th Degree Burglary and Trespass after he was observed inside a vacant apartment by a maintenance worker. The suspect fled the area but was detained nearby and positively identified. The youth was released to a guardian pending action by the Juvenile Justice System.
11/05 8:00 P.M.	9100 block Edmonston Road. Burglary. Unknown person(s) used unknown means to enter a residence and took clothing, shoes a suitcase and electronic equipment.

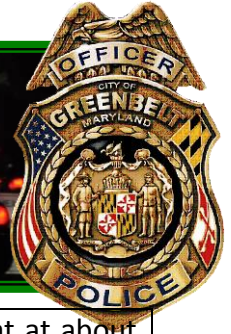
