**Crescent Road and Westway Crosswalk

**Subject:** Request for a crosswalk

**Discussion:** The Committee discussed and evaluated the need for a crosswalk and/or pedestrian caution sign just beyond the intersection of Crescent Road and Westway in the direction of the library.

It was brought to the attention of the Committee that there is no crosswalk that connects to an indented curb that leads to the underpass near the library. The indented curb is shown in accompanying photos. The committee is concerned that because it is not a 3-way stop, traffic is not made aware of pedestrians. A stop sign on Crescent Road may also be a solution.



While the underpass does allow pedestrians to avoid the intersection there is still no access for pedestrians attempting to cross Crescent Road.



**Recommendation:** The Youth Advisory Committee recommends the implementation of a crosswalk and/or yellow caution sign and/or stop sign.


