

PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE REGULAR MEETING

April 1, 2014

ROLL CALL: Present were Dr. Laura Kressler, Stan Zirkin, Matthew Inzeo, Eunice Pierre, Mary Thomas, William James and Cindy Comproni. Also present were Daniel Gomez, Kris White, Shirley Middleton, Lester Whitmer and City liaisons Captain Tom Kemp and Mary Johnson.

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m.

MINUTES: The minutes from the March 4, 2014 meeting were approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS: Continued discussion of crosswalk concerns – Dr. Kressler asked members to make a list of their crosswalk concerns. Some crosswalk concerns discussed were:

- Northway and Ridge Road
- Cherrywood Lane between Kenilworth Avenue and Greenbelt Metro Drive
- Crescent and Gardenway
- Cherryhill and Ivy
- Ridge Road and Eastway
- Laurel Hill Road – lack of crosswalks
- Hanover Parkway

Playground surfacing referral letter was approved to be sent to Council.

Advisory group requirements letter was approved to be sent to Council.

NEW BUSINESS: Upcoming Referrals – PSAC is expecting to receive referrals on the following:

- Food Truck Referral
- Emergency Preparedness Referral – The Greenbelt Police Department is in the process of reviewing.

Are You Ready: Incentive items – Magnets, palm cards, flashlights, whistle and flashlights and brochures were reviewed. PSAC has pens and pencils with the logo on them.

Crosswalk Discussion – Bike Pedestrian Plan – PSAC members were asked to read the sections on crosswalks and sidewalks and is ready to discuss at the next meeting. Celia Craze, Director of Community Planning and Development asked PSAC to bring to her attention any problems.

Dr. Kressler suggested she may hold 1 or 2 public forums concerning crosswalks and traffic in the City. These forums will be publicized in the News Review, the City cable channel and the Greenbelt list serve.

Mrs. Comproni will not be at the April PSAC meeting but will send dates that she available for the forums and any concerns.
