

MEETING OF PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE
September 2, 2014

ROLL CALL: The meeting of the Public Safety Advisory Committee was called to order at 7:05p.m. Present were Dr. Laura Kressler, Cynthia Comproni, Stan Zirkin, Mary Thomas, Matt Inzeo and William James. City Liaisons Captain Kemp, Mary Johnson and Assistant City Manager David Moran were also present.

NEW BUSINESS: Referral – Emergency Operations Plan – Assistant City Manager, David Moran went over the Emergency Preparedness and Operations Plan which was distributed to all members. PSAC members suggested changes to the plan and asked to see the remainder of the plan that is not publicized. Mr. Moran stated he will strategize how to get the remainder of the plan to PSAC. PSAC will continue to review the Emergency Operations Plan.

Mr. Moran reviewed and demonstrated the new Greenbelt Alert System and distributed Greenbelt Alert informational cards. Dr. Kressler suggested that a detailed article about the new alert system be placed in the News Review. Mrs. Comproni suggested educational sessions be conducted for the public. Mr. Moran agreed that we need to continue to publicize the alert system.
