

PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE REGULAR MEETING  
December 10, 2013

ROLL CALL: Present were members Dr. Laura Kressler, Mary Thomas, Stan Zirkin, William James, and Cynthia Comproni. Also present was Capt. Kemp. The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m.

ABSENT: Matthew Inzeo and Eunice Pierre

MINUTES: The minutes from the meetings on November 4<sup>th</sup> were approved as read.

COMMUNICATIONS: GHI held an event "Are you ready" and requested that PSAC cosponsor next year.

OLD BUSINESS: PLAYGROUND SURFACES: Dr. Kressler stated that Council Liaison Ms. Pope instructed the committee to take economics out of the committee's judgments and decide on safety.

Mr. Zirkin, Ms. Comproni, and Ms. Pierre attended the PRAB meeting held on playground surfaces. Mr. Zirkin gave a report on the meeting. He will prepare a written report for PSAC.

NEW BUSINESS: COUNCIL LIAISON: Dr. Kressler reported that Council Member Silke Pope will be the Council Liaison for PSAC. She also noted that the Council have several new referrals for the committee in 2014. One referral was requested by Council Member Konrad Herling on Disaster Planning. Mrs. Comproni suggested that the committee should request funds for 2014 Budget to assist PSAC in events.

CROSSWALKS: Dr. Kressler requested a list of crosswalk concerns. She also stated that Mrs. Craze needs to come to a meeting to discuss. It was noted that there were concerns with Gardenway and Crescent crosswalk as being too busy and distracting. Also, that a request was made for a crosswalk on Ridge Road near the Mowatt Church and on Mandan Road.

FIREHOUSE: Mrs. Comproni requested that the committee address community firehouse's decision on how to staff the facility due to decline in volunteers. A firehouse outside the community was responding to the calls. Captain Kemp announced that as of last weekend, paid firefighters were now staffing the firehouse full time.
