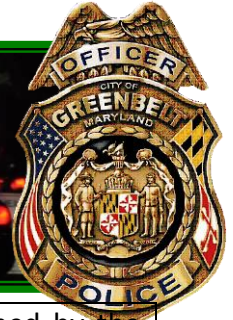

The suspect asked the victim if he wanted to buy a laptop computer for under the retail price. The victim agreed to buy the laptop and after giving the suspect money, the victim later discovered that there was no laptop in the box. The suspect is described as a black male, 6'1" to 6'3", 180 to 190 pounds, wearing a black baseball cap, a black t shirt and khaki shorts. The suspect left the scene in a vehicle described as a black Nissan Altima bearing Maryland tags.

The victims advised that they were walking in the 7800 block of Hanover Parkway while playing Pokemon Go when they passed the three suspects who were at the bus stop. The suspects then began following the two to the 8000 block of Mandan Road, at which time the suspects ran towards the victims, with one suspect brandishing a knife while announcing a robbery. One of victims then threw her cell phone to the ground. One of the suspects grabbed the cell phone and all three suspects fled the scene on foot. The suspects are described as a black male, 5'5", with black hair, wearing a dark shirt with an unknown type of flag on it; a black male, 5'5", with orange hair, wearing a black shirt and a black male, 5'10", bald and wearing some type of face covering.

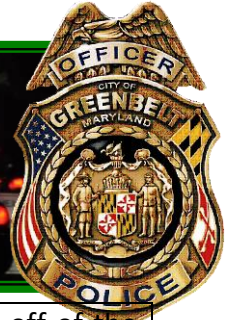
