When he answered the door, three suspects forced their way into the residence. The suspects, all armed with handguns, ordered the victim to the ground. After taking money and the victim's cell phone the suspects fled the scene. The suspects fled the area in a vehicle described as a white Kia Optima 4-door. The suspects are described as a black male with a heavy build, 5'9", 200 pounds, with a dark complexion and a goatee, wearing a grey sweatshirt and black pants; a black male, 6', 300 pounds, wearing a brown and grey camouflage Jacket and an unknown subject 5'2", 120 to 130 pounds with an unknown type of face covering.

Jerrod Damien Bishop, 19, of Greenbelt, Shawn Lee Spencer, 18, of Greenbelt and Brandon Devon Scott, 18, of Hyattsville, MD were arrested and charged with Theft after the victim, a taxi driver, positively identified the suspects the three subjects who fled his cab without paying the fare. The suspects were released on citation pending trial.
10/17 6:20 A.M.	6300 block Ivy Lane. Vandalism. The victim advised that he was driving to work when he was cut off by an aggressive driver. The subject followed him into the parking lot and engaged in a verbal altercation with the victim. The victim used his cell phone to take a picture of the suspect. The suspect grabbed the phone, threw it to the ground then fled the scene. The suspect is described as a white male, 5'9", 200 pounds, with brown hair and a beard, wearing a plaid shirt. The suspect vehicle is described as a white SUV, no further.

Jerrell Tyshawn Henry, 25, of Greenbelt was arrested and charged with Reckless Endangerment after he allegedly fired several shots at random with a handgun in the nearby wooded area. The suspect was located coming out of a apartment and was arrested. A search warrant of the apartment was obtained and a handgun was recovered. The suspect was transported to the Department of Corrections for a hearing before a District Court Commissioner.

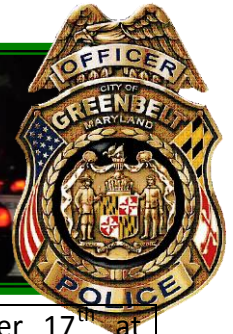
GREENBELT EAST/GREENWAY SHOPPING CENTER
