



The victim, a pharmacist at the CVS, advised that two suspects entered the store and approached the counter, while the other two suspects drove up to the drive-through window and began speaking with the pharmacist. The two suspects in the store then jumped the counter and took a quantity of pharmaceutical medicine and fled the store, getting into the vehicle with the other two suspects and fleeing the scene. A Prince George's County Police Officer observed the vehicle and followed them onto the Baltimore/Washington Parkway, joined by Greenbelt officers. The vehicle was stopped in the area of the B/W Parkway and Landover Road and the suspects were arrested. The suspects were transported to the Department of Corrections for a hearing before a District Court Commissioner.
