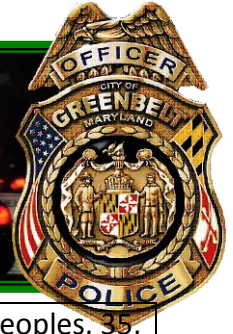

On March 29 th a witness flagged down an officer and pointed out a possible suspect, who was positively identified by the victim and arrested. The 16 year old Greenbelt youth was arrested for Strong Arm Robbery and Second Degree Assault. The youth was released to a parent pending action by the Juvenile Justice System. |

No description was given for the second suspect. |

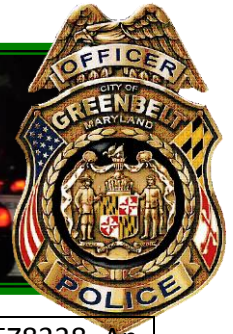
