



The victim advised that on February 28 th at approximately 4:50 P.M. he was walking along a footpath when he was approached by three suspects, with one punching the victim as he passed by, causing the victim to fall to the ground. The suspect then took the victim's cell phone and left the scene with the other two suspects. The suspects are described as a black male, 16 to 18 years of age, 5'10", 170 to 200 pounds, with black hair with 'twists' on top, wearing a green jacket and two other black males, younger, each with a dark complexion, 5'8", 130 to 160 pounds. No reason was given for the delay in reporting the incident.

Troy Lamont Sweetney, 26, of Rockville, MD was arrested and charged with Possession of Cocaine, Drinking in Public, False Statement, Public Intoxication/Causing a Disturbance and Trespass by officers responding to a report of a disorderly subject. The suspect was transported to the Department of Correction for a hearing before a District Court Commissioner.

The suspect then threatened her and walked away. The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, 5'7", with curly hair, wearing a red, white and black winter jacket, black pants, blue sandals and a black backpack with a large Nike emblem on it.
