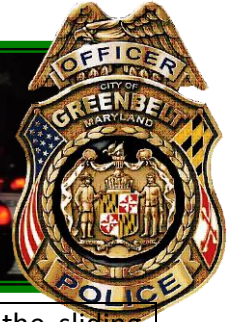

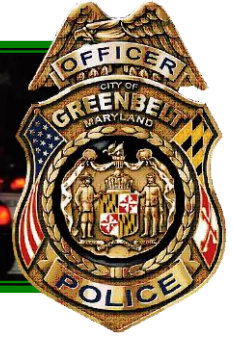


04/16 4:00 P.M.	9000 block Breezewood Terrace. Vandalism. Unknown person(s) broke out the sliding glass door of a residence.

The victim was transported to Prince George's General Hospital for treatment. Several suspects have been developed and arrest warrants are pending.

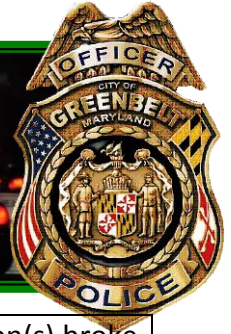
