



Demetrius Lamar Foster, 20, of no fixed address, was arrested and charged with Armed Carjacking; Use of a Handgun During the Commission of a Felony; Transporting a Handgun and Robbery after the suspect, along with a second suspect, allegedly robbed the victim at gunpoint, took the victim's vehicle and fled the scene. A short time later a Berwyn Heights Police Officer observed the stolen vehicle being driven in Berwyn Heights. The suspect vehicle then fled the area back into Greenbelt, where it collided into a parked car in the area of Springhill Drive and Cherrywood Lane. The suspects exited the vehicle and fled the area on foot. During a search of the area the Foster suspect was found hiding in the bathroom inside the laundry facility in the 9100 block of Springhill Lane, was positively identified and arrested. The suspect was transported to the Department of Corrections for a hearing before a District Court Commissioner. The only description of a second suspect was a person wearing a mask.



07/12 1:32 A.M.	9300 block Edmonston Road. Burglary. Entry was possibly gained by way of an unlocked window. A backpack was taken.


