RESOLUTION NUMBER 2053

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF REPLACEMENT BOILERS AT THE AQUATIC AND FITNESS CENTER FROM DENSEL COMPANY AT AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$217,420.

WHEREAS, since 2016 existing boilers have been showing physical signs of failure from degradation of the interior jacketing and damaged exterior casing; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are essential to the operation of the facility; and


WHEREAS, the City hired a mechanical engineering firm to design the new boiler system and make recommendation to replace existing boiler equipment that has reached the end of its useful life, and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal was issued to pre-qualified firms; and


WHEREAS, the proposal from Densel Company was determined to be in the City's best interest. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to negotiate the purchase of Greenbelt Aquatic Fitness Center Boiler Replacement Project from Densel Company at an estimated cost of \$217,420.00.
