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RESOLUTION NUMBER 1031

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE OF A SURVEILLANCE CAMERA SYSTEM FOR THE AQUATIC & FITNESS CENTER WITH AVRIO GROUP SURVEILLANCE SOLUTIONS, INC., OF EASTON, MARYLAND, AT A COST OF \$25,941

WHEREAS, the current security camera system an the Aquatic & Fitness Center is 17 years old and very ineffective; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2008 Building Capital Reserve Fund includes funds to upgrade and replace this camera system; and

WHEREAS, staff has been pleased with the performance of the Roosevelt Center camera surveillance system purchased from Avrio Group Surveillance Solutions; and

WHEREAS, the Avrio Group has submitted a proposal that will offer the same qualities and capabilities as the Roosevelt Center system including the ability for authorized users to view and control the system via the City's computer network; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to ensure compatibility among both of these camera surveillance systems and the system proposed by Avrio has been determined to have all the features the City desires. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to negotiate the purchase of a new digital camera surveillance system at the Aquatic & Fitness Center from Avrio Group Surveillance Solutions, Inc., of Easton, Maryland, at a cost of \$25,941 as offered in their quotation of May 27, 2008.
