RESOLUTION NUMBER 1035

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE OF A PUBLIC RESTROOM TO BE LOCATED IN BUDDY ATTICK PARK WITH RESTROOM SOLUTIONS, INC., OF PHOENIX, AZ., AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$111,670

WHEREAS, the City and its citizens would benefit from the presence of a public restroom at Buddy Attick Park; and

WHEREAS, a 50 percent matching grant from Project Open Space was received in 2005 up to the amount of \$100,000 for the construction of such a building; and

WHEREAS, pre-fabricated buildings are a cost effective alternative to on-site construction; and

WHEREAS, quotes for this project were received from seven national manufacturers of pre-fabricated restrooms; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Restroom Solutions, Inc., of Phoenix, AZ., was determined to offer the most on-site construction support and manufacture a quality product in Lagrange KY; and

WHEREAS, final architectural designs can be specified and ordered once a contract for construction has been approved by the City Council. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to negotiate the purchase of public restroom, model number DW42-2225LA, plans and materials, from Restroom Solutions Inc., of Phoenix, Arizona, at a cost not to exceed \$111,670

PASSED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, at its regular meeting of July 14, 2008.
