RESOLUTION NUMBER 1055

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE OF A COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH/RECORDS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FROM NEW WORLD SYSTEMS CORPORATION OF TROY, MICHIGAN AT AN APPROXIMATE COST OF \$603,820, BUT NOT TO EXCEED \$625,000.

WHEREAS, a Computer Aided Dispatch/Records Management System (CAD/RMS) is necessary to increase public safety, officer safety, and efficiency and productivity within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenbelt in conjunction with the City of Hyattsville issued a Request for Proposal for a CAD/RMS system for our respective Police Departments in December 2007; and

WHEREAS, a team of Police and Information Technology staff representatives from both cities have reviewed vendor responses, received vendor demonstrations, conducted site visits, and analyzed and debated the proposals; and

WHEREAS, based on the work, the team has determined the New World Systems' proposal best meets the cities' needs at a cost comparable to the other proposals; and

WHEREAS, the staff team and attorneys from both cities have satisfactorily negotiated a proposed contract with New World Systems. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to contract with New World Systems Corporation for the purchase, installation, training and ongoing support of their proposed solution for an integrated Computer Aided Dispatch and Records Management System at an approximate cost of \$603,820, but not to exceed \$625,000.
