RESOLUTION NUMBER 1005

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE OF A REFUSE TRUCK FROM GRANTURK EQUIPMENT COMPANY, INC., OF BALTIMORE, MARYLAND, AT A COST OF \$132,554

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WHEREAS, the FY 2007 Replacement Fund includes \$135,000 for the purchase of a refuse truck to replace an 11-year-old Public Works vehicle; and

WHEREAS, a bid awarded by the City of Bowie for refuse trucks would meet the City's needs with some modifications, including the substitution of an International Harvester chassis for the Sterling chassis, as well as the addition of a number of options, including, but not limited to, cart lifters; and

WHEREAS, although using a bid, staff considers the extent of needed modifications to justify consideration by the City Council of a resolution for negotiated purchase; and

WHEREAS, although the preferred chassis is available in current inventory for immediate purchase, changes in federal regulations for trucks with diesel motors will soon increase the cost of these trucks substantially. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to negotiate the purchase of a 25-cubic yard refuse truck from GranTurk Equipment Company, Inc., of Baltimore at a cost of \$132,554 as offered in their letter of June 23, 2006.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
