RESOLUTION NUMBER 1009

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE OF CITATION COLLECTION SERVICES FROM COMPLUS DATA INNOVATIONS, INC., OF TARRYTOWN, NY

WHEREAS, the City has for a number of years contracted with a vendor to collect outstanding parking citations and manage the database for current and future citations; and

WHEREAS, the collection of delinquent parking tickets is a specialized business requiring an understanding of the motor vehicle laws in all 50 states; and

WHEREAS, Complus Data Innovations is an expert in this business and can provide a number of features not available through the current vendor, including, but not limited to, the provision of handheld automated ticket writers; and

WHEREAS, staff has negotiated a proposal to perform this work in which Complus retains 15% of the amount paid for any collected citations. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to enter into an agreement with Complus Data Innovations, Inc., of Tarrytown, New York, as outlined in its proposed agreement dated October 18, 2006.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
