RESOLUTION NUMBER 1010

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE OF CONSERVATION SERVICES REQUIRED FOR THE CONSERVATION TREATMENT OF BAS RELIEF FRIEZES AND MOTHER AND CHILD STATUE WITH CONSERVATION SOLUTIONS, INC., OF WASHINGTON, DC, AT A LUMP SUM COST OF \$29,064

WHEREAS, the bas-relief friezes adorning the Greenbelt Community Center and the Mother and Child Statue in Roosevelt Center have been in need of cleaning and repairs for several years; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a fifty percent matching grant from the Maryland Historical Trust in the amount of \$22,500 to clean and repair these bas-relief friezes and the Mother and Child Statue; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Historical Trust provided a list of experienced object conservators, from which the City solicited requests for qualifications and proposals for the subject work; and

WHEREAS, of the nine object conservators invited to respond, two submitted proposals; and

WHEREAS, Conservation Solutions, Inc., of Washington, DC, has extensive experience in the field of conservation, including limestone work, and submitted the lowest cost proposal to complete said project at a lump sum cost of \$29,064; and

WHEREAS, the City has sufficient funds in the Capital Projects Fund to pay for this work.
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to contract with the Conservation Solutions, Inc., of Washington, DC, to provide conservation services for the conservation treatment of the bas-relief friezes adorning the Community Center and the Mother and Child Statue in Roosevelt Center for a lump sum cost of \$29,064.
