RESOLUTION NUMBER 961

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE NEGOTIATED PURCHASE OF CERTAIN GOODS AND SERVICES FROM VARIOUS VENDORS AS ENUMERATED HEREIN WHEN TOTAL FISCAL YEAR PURCHASES FROM EACH VENDOR EXCEED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000)

WHEREAS, Section 40, "Purchases," of the Charter of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, as amended, authorizes the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, to waive bidding procedures and to authorize, by resolution, a negotiated purchase or contract whenever it is in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, the purchases of certain goods and services from certain vendors during Fiscal Year 2004 individually may total less than \$10,000 but will, nevertheless, in the aggregate exceed \$10,000 for the year; and

WHEREAS, payment for the various vendors will be based on the best current negotiated or contract price available; and

WHEREAS, monies for these goods and services have already been approved by City Council in the Fiscal Year 2004 budget; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined it to be in the best interest of the city to purchase the goods and services listed for the enumerated reasons on a negotiated basis; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be and hereby is authorized to purchase the following goods and services listed.
