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
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CAMP MISSION STATEMENT

Greenbelt Recreation is committed to ensuring a safe, nurturing, and fun environment for all its campers. Behavior policies are enforced in a fair and consistent manner.

MEMORY QUEST IN CENTRAL PARK

"I know I can touch the sky!"

Campers spread their wings and soar at Creative Kids Camp, where the emphasis is on **creativity and fun!** Guided by enthusiastic mentors, campers explore the arts and develop their talents, all while making new friends and having fun in a caring environment that affirms every child. Activities include acting, improv, dance and movement, singing, ceramics and visual art. Campers also enjoy twice-weekly supervised free swim at the adjacent Greenbelt Aquatic and Fitness Center's outdoor pool. At the end of each session, campers proudly perform in a musical theater show for parents and other loved ones.



Our camp show this summer is *Memory Quest In Central Park*, about a group of cousins who explore the famous park, hoping to retrieve memories for their grandmother, who has become frail and forgetful. The explorers visit the Carousel, the Bethesda Fountain, the Chess and Checkers House, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Cleopatra's Needle, the Swedish Cottage Marionette Theater, the Conservatory Sailboat Pond, and the outdoor Delacorte Theatre, for a performance of Shakespeare under the stars!

Like the characters in the show, our campers will be learning about the importance of preserving family and community memories by hearing and recording the stories of their grandparents and other seniors.

AGES 13-17


PERICLES, Prince Of Tyre

Perilous circumstances force young Prince Pericles to become a refugee. One adventure follows another as the wandering prince seeks to return home and be reunited with his family. Rarely performed, this play is Shakespeare’s hidden treasure, filled with miracles, music and mystery -- and a cast of extraordinarily colorful characters. Camp Encore’s production will offer young actors a chance to sail the Mediterranean and explore the mysteries and enchantments of the ancient world —all without leaving Greenbelt.

Juggling, stilt-walking, unicycling, equilibratics, balance boards, slack line, rolling globe, partner acrobatics, and clowning are all on the menu, including how to safely slip on a banana peel or take a pie in the face! Campers are safely taught at their individual skill level. They will also enjoy supervised swim once per week in the outdoor pool. At the end of every camp session, campers will demonstrate their new skills in performance.

BEFORE & AFTER CARE

BEFORE AND AFTER CARE

These extended-day offerings are available for all camps (except Fast Break Basketball Clinic). During Before Care and After Care, lightly structured activities and free play areas are supervised by camp staff. Greenbelt Recreation supports proper nutrition for extended-day campers by offering breakfast and snacks at no extra charge:

- Breakfast is served during Before Care, up to 8:15am. Campers can choose one of three nutritious breakfast options: (1) a bowl of Cheerios, (2) a slice of whole-grain toast with peanut butter, or (3) a bowl of instant oatmeal, each with milk and juice or fresh fruit.
- A nutritious snack is provided to all campers during After Care.

Before Care and After Care take place in the same building as the regular camp in which the camper is enrolled, except for Camp Encore where After Care is provided at the Community Center.

AFTER CARE CLASSES

CLAY AT THE END OF THE DAY

Campers will cultivate their artistic voice while learning how to build and glaze their own ceramic artwork through a variety of structured activities. Students will also develop their technical vocabulary and learn how to be a considerate user/participant in a community studio. We strive to provide a learning environment that is both peaceful and positive. Concentration, respect and personal responsibility are among the keys to success. These classes are great preparation for the many youth ceramics programs offered during the school year, as well as being fun experiences in themselves!

Campers ages 6-9 will learn hand-building and decoration techniques, creating sculpture and pottery. Children ages 11 to 14 will be introduced to the potter's wheel, and will have the option to work on hand-building projects as well. Ten year old campers may participate in either class according to their experience and abilities. Campers may be picked up a Camp HQ (the ground floor east suite) at 5:15pm.

Is this program a good fit for my camper? If the following description applies to your child at this point in their development, then the answer is YES!

- Enjoys working on projects in a focused way for an extended period of time
- Is receptive to guidance, excited about learning new skills, and willing to “try, try again”
- Is comfortable remaining seated in the classroom and able to sustain an “indoor voice”
- Follows instructions promptly and takes personal responsibility for clean-up
- Understands that class time is not intended for free play; participation in group activities is required.

Forms also may be picked up at the Greenbelt Youth Center and the Greenbelt Community Center during all facility hours. We recommend that you fill out the forms at home where you have access to necessary information such as medication data and emergency contact numbers.

COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORMS can be submitted by mail, email, fax, or in person. All camp contact information is provided below. Forms will be accepted from Greenbelt residents* for Spring & Summer Camps beginning on February 3 and from non-residents beginning on February 18. Mail-in registrations and faxed registrations will be dated and entered accordingly. Camper registration forms will be accepted on an ongoing basis until all slots are filled. At that point, interested persons' names will be placed on a waiting list. Those persons will be contacted in the order in which names were taken if/when a slot becomes available.
